## **AMENDMENTS TO 2023 POLICY & PROCEDURES**

September 30, 2023

Each item will be presented as already having a motion to either approve or reject according to the recommendation of the Legislation Committee. Each item will be presented separately.

Any item is subject to amendment by the House of Delegates, provided the amendment is germane to the proposal.

Such amendments must be adopted by a simple majority. Subsequently, the proposal as amended shall be presented for approval.

Anyone wishing to speak to any proposal should raise his/her hand. Once recognized by the Chair, the individual should stand, state his/her name and affiliation or position, state whether speaking in favor or against the motion, and briefly state the reasoning.

A motion to close debate (call the question) can be made only by someone who has been recognized by the Chair.

Such motion is not debatable and an immediate vote to close debate will be taken.

NOTE: THE FOLLOWING LEGISLATION REQUIRES 90% APPROVAL FROM THOSE PRESENT AND VOTING.

To allow families the flexibility of travel & finances, along with direct supervision of the well-being of their swimmer during the Zone Meet. To allow for compensation to Coaches and Staff putting in time and effort for the Lake Erie Zone Team to attend Zones.

- C. The Zone Team Committee shall be responsible for administering the affairs of the Zone Team, including but not limited to arranging for uniforms, transportation for Coaches & Zone Coordinator, booking team hotel block & lodging for Coaches, meals for Coaches & Team meals, and team entry.
  - D. Unless the Board determines that sufficient funds are unavailable, the Zone Team shall be funded by LESI in the amount of \$80 \u220550 per day of Zone Team competition and travel for each Pool Swimmer and \$80 total for each Open Water Swimmer, by participant fees, and by donations.
  - G. All 11 and Over swimmers and coaches of the Zone Team must travel, lodge and eat with the Zone Team until withdrawal from the Team or the conclusion of the Zone Team trip. All 10 and Under swimmers may will travel with their families, stay with their families at the team hotel and arrange their own meals unless a team meal is being held, in which team meals will be mandatory, and pay a LESI Policy and 'Procedures lesser participant fee. LESI Board may grant exceptions to this policy with the agreement of the Zone Committee.
    - All swimmers will attend prelims & finals of each Zone session for their age group, excluding Sunday, in which swimmers may leave at the end of the prelim session, if their personal competition schedule is over for the meet.
    - 2. Barring extenuating circumstances, no swimmers will be permitted to declare a false start during the meet or scratch from finals without permission of the Head Zone Coach.
    - H. The following will be covered by LESI for Coaches (up to 4) and the Zone Chair:
      - 1. Hotel Room-Coaches of the same gender will stay two (2) people to a room when possible
      - 2. One Rental Car/staff
      - 3. Team Shirts
      - 4. \$40/day for food with the team
